 - C. Attach an official transcript in sealed school stationery, authenticated by the school transcript official. Transcript will include your grades covering the first seven semesters of high school.
 - D. Attach a copy of your SAT and Achievement test scores. Here you may include academic honors and athletic involvement.
 - E. OPTIONAL QUESTION: Are there any financial concerns you have, that you wish us to consider in evaluating your need for a scholarship? (for example: single parent only supporting college, other siblings currently in college, recent loss of salary, etc.)

Semi finalists will be asked to come for a personal interview. The time will be set at the convenience of the Scholarship Committee and the applicant.

This application must be signed by the applicant and his/her parent or guardian. Applicants will be disqualified if application instructions are not followed or the application is incomplete.
